

## TAKE THIS TO YOUR VET...

***Standard interstate health papers are required for the Midwest Stud Ram Sale.***

*Obtain health papers and any tests on June 5th or later to allow traveling time for the new owners after the sale.*

***ALL ENTRIES MUST HAVE SCRAPIE TAGS IN EAR AND LISTED ON THE HEALTH PAPERS.***

**Sale Date: June 24-29, 2019**

**Sale Location: Missouri State Fair Grounds, 2503 W 16th St, Sedalia, MO 65301**

***Below is the language we need to have your vet include on the health papers:***

*"I have examined these entries and this flock of origin and they are free of any apparent evidence of any infections or communicable diseases, including foot rot, epididymitis, sore mouth, caseous lymphadenitis, scabies, and there has been no evidence of scrapie within the past 60 months."*

***Required Testing:*** All Yearling Rams and Fall Ram Lambs (born before January 1st of this year) must have ELISA test for B. Ovis within 30 days of the sale. Only rams with negative B. Ovis results will be allowed to sell. A positive result suggests epididymitis which can render rams sterile.

***If you have a B.Ovis free flock, vet must record "B. Ovis free flock" on health paper and GIVE FLOCK CERTIFICATION NUMBER.***

**See back of consignor letter for instructions on obtaining ELISA Test for B. Ovis.**

***Consignors must bring their paperwork (or send with fitter) to be checked in by 3pm prior to show day.***
