### NATIONAL CORRIEDALE JUNIOR SHOW Eligibility/Rules:

1. Junior dues of \$10.00 must be paid to the American Corriedale Association prior to the show. Exhibitors must be from 8 to 21 years of age on show day to participate.
2. Limit of 2 entries per class, any entries must be shown by a Junior.
3. Classes may be split again if numbers warrant and funds are available after check-in.
4. Ownership may be in Junior, Family or Farm Name. Registration papers will be checked prior to show.
5. A "Natural" ewe lamb class is offered with the following requirements: *Fleeces may be tipped or fuzzed off, but not blocked or fitted. Fleeces must be the same length. No coloring or painting of the animal. Leg-washing optional. Hand trimming of tags around legs and dung balls in dock area permitted. 1st and 2nd place animals qualify to show in appropriate championship drives.*
6. Sale entries are eligible to show in junior show.
7. Pens may not be available for non-sale Junior Show entries. Those sheep will likely stay on trailers or in transit pens available in Horse Barns.

**Health Papers: SAME RULES APPLY TO ALL JUNIOR SHOW SHEEP.** Standard interstate health paper (or copy of paper) is required for each animal, and will be turned in to sale management at check-in. Obtain health papers on June 5th or later to allow traveling time for the new owners after the sale. **All Entries are subject to random vet checks.** All entries must have scrapie tags!

**Penning:** Pens may not be available for any non-sale Junior Show entries. Those sheep will most likely stay on trailers or in transit pens available in Horse Barns. Only if space is available, then penning chart will include section for junior show sheep pens.
