Registration papers will be checked prior to show.</li> <li>A "Natural" ewe lamb class is offered with the following requirements: <i>Fleeces may be tipped or fuzzed off, but not blocked or fitted. Fleeces must be the same length. No coloring or painting of the animal. Leg-washing optional.
